

ORDINANCE # 351

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE TITLE II, DIVISION I, CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 3, "VIOLATION OF STATE REGULATIONS". (2.1-2.0301)

ARTICLE 3, GENERAL REGULATIONS, 2.1-2.0301 "VIOLATION OF STATE REGULATIONS" SHALL BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

(1) Shall be amended with the addition of:

- A. NO DRIVERS LICENSE, IA 321.174. This applies to a person that has never had a license, needs to be reinstated, suspended out of state, or has not paid a victim reparation fee. This shall be a City fine of \$100.00, plus surcharge and court costs.
- B. EXPIRED DRIVERS LICENSE, IA 321.174A. The City fine for an expired drivers license is \$20.00 plus court costs and surcharge.

(4) Shall be amended with the addition of:

- A. DAMAGE TO VEHICLE, IA 321.262
- B. INFORMATION AND AID-LEAVING THE SCENE OF AN ACCIDENT, IA 321.263
- C. STRIKING AN UNATTENDED VEHICLE, IA 321.264
- D. STRIKING FIXTURES UPON A HIGHWAY, IA 321.265

(6) Shall be amended with the addition of:

Skidding tires and popping wheelies, IA 321.277A. These shall be a City fine of \$25.00 plus court costs and surcharge.

(15) Shall be amended with the addition of:

SEAT BELTS: IA 321.445 and 321.446. The City fines shall be the same as the State of Iowa fines.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase hereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.


This ordinance shall become effective upon publication as required by law.
