

ORDINANCE # 359

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING 2.1-2.0605 OF THE BUFFALO, IA CITY CODE, (ORDINANCE #302):

WHEREAS: STOP signs were put at Fourth St. and Jefferson, facing North and South and the Northbound sign is covered during the winter months.

AND WHEREAS: The covering of the Northbound sign has created a dangerous situation for vehicles going East and West that are not aware of the sign being covered and expect them to stop.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BUFFALO, IA:

The Northbound STOP sign will not be covered at any time and the intersection will remain a four way stop at all times.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase hereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

This ordinance shall become effective upon publication as required by law.
