

ORDINANCE # 362

AN ORDINANCE FOR FEES FOR USAGE OF OVERHEAD LIGHTS AT BUFFALO CITY PARK:

WHEREAS: There are individuals and/or groups who may wish to use the overhead ball diamond lights for ball games or practice sessions.

AND WHEREAS: The Buffalo Dads Club and the Buffalo Parents Club have youth that play games and practice at the Buffalo City Park and may use the overhead lights without any fees due from the youth of these two groups during scheduled games and/or practices.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BUFFALO, IA:

Any other persons wishing to use the overhead lights at the Buffalo City Park, other than the two groups listed above, must arrange in advance to have a designated person from the park board present to turn the lights on and collect a fee of \$10.00 per hour, in advance, and be present to turn off the lights when the allotted time is over. No keys will be given out to anyone other than city employees or park board members or managers.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase hereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

This ordinance shall become effective upon publication as required by law.
