ORDINANCE # 368

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Buffalo to allow the use of skateboards on public property, and;

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Buffalo to appoint its board members on an annual basis and elect/appoint a chairperson at the January meeting,

THEREFORE, Section 2.1-7.01 and Section 2.1-7.02, which read as follows:

Section 2.1-7.01 Prohibited use of skateboards. It shall be unlawful to ride, operate or use a skateboard upon the sidewalks, public streets, alleys parking lots or city owned areas.

Section 2.1-7.02 Violation and Penalty. Any person violating the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by imprisonment not to exceed thirty (30) days, or by a fine of not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00)

shall be deleted from the Buffalo Municipal Code, and;

THEREFORE, the following amendments shall be made:

Section 5-1.0102 Appointment and term currently states, "One commissioner shall be appointed annually for a term of five (5) years commencing October 1 of each year."

Section 5-1.0102 Appointment and term is amended to read as follows: This board shall be appointed on an annual basis at the regularly scheduled January City Council Meeting.

Section 5-1.0103 Organization currently states, "Within ten (10) days following the appointment, the board shall elect one of its members as chairman."

Section 5-1.0103 Organization is amended to read as follows: At the January meeting of this board they shall elect/appoint one of its members as chairperson.

Full force and effect. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of passage and publication as required by law.

Repealer. This ordinance shall be construed to repeal any prior ordinance inconsistent herewith.

Severability of provisions. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed as separate, distinct, and independent provision as such holdings shall not be affected the validity of the remaining portion hereof.
