AMENDMENT # 393

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the City of Buffalo to clarify the responsibilities of the Fire Chief and the Buffalo City Council regarding the disposition of fire equipment;

**THEREFORE**, be it resolved that Section 2.2-1.04, paragraph 4 of the Buffalo Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

4. **Property.** He shall recommend to the city council the disposition of fire apparatus, tools, equipment and other property used by or belonging to the fire department. The city council shall have full control over the disposition of all fire apparatus, tools, equipment and other property used by or belonging to the fire department.


**Full force and effect.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of passage and publication as required by law.


**Repealer.** This ordinance shall be construed to repeal any prior ordinance inconsistent herewith.

**Severability of provisions.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion hereof.
