

**CITY OF BUFFALO  
ORDINANCE NO. 418**

An Ordinance creating Section 2.1-2.1015(4) of the Municipal Code of the City of Buffalo relating to Parking Restrictions

**WHEREAS**, from time to time it is necessary to amend the Buffalo Municipal Code to ensure the public safety.

**THEREFORE**, be it resolved that the following amendment is to be made to the Buffalo Municipal Code:

1. Section 2.1-2.1015 (4) is hereby created to read as follows:

**Section 2.1-2.1015 Restricted Parking on Designated Streets**

4. No semi-trailer truck, tractor-trailer, or recreational vehicle shall be allowed to park along the north side of Front Street from Clark Street to Franklin Street.


**Full force and effect.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of passage and publication as required by law.


**Repealer.** This ordinance shall be construed to repeal any prior ordinance inconsistent herewith.

**Severability of provisions.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed as separate, distinct, and independent provision as such holdings shall not be affected the validity of the remaining portion hereof.
