

**CITY OF BUFFALO
ORDINANCE NO. 422**

An Ordinance amending Section 2.1-1.0303 of the Municipal Code of the City of Buffalo
relating to Minors

WHEREAS, from time to time it is necessary to amend the Buffalo Municipal Code to ensure the public health and safety.

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the following amendment is to be made to the Buffalo Municipal Code:

1. Section 2.1-1.0303 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2.1-1.0303 Minors in Taverns.

It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of eighteen (18) years of age to enter, remain in, or frequent a business establishment whose main purpose is to serve alcoholic beverages without their parent, guardian or responsible adult of age.

Minors may frequent a business establishment holding a retail liquor or beer permit whose main purpose is to serve food for the purpose of eating a meal between the hours of 7 AM and 8 PM without their parent, guardian or responsible adult of age.

2. Section 2.1-3.0919 (9) is hereby deleted.


Full force and effect. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of passage and publication as required by law.

Repealer. This ordinance shall be construed to repeal any prior ordinance inconsistent herewith.

Severability of provisions. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed as separate, distinct, and independent provision as such holdings shall not be affected the validity of the remaining portion hereof.
