

RESOLUTION # 16-94

A RESOLUTION REINSTATING THE FIVE TON LOAD AS DEFINED IN TITLE 11, DIVISION 1, CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 7, SECTION 2.1-2.0703 OF THE CITY CODE OF BUFFALO, IOWA:

WHEREAS: The Council of the City of Buffalo, Iowa, has found that such road and street conditions exist that heavy traffic may be detrimental to the maintenance of said streets, and the sewers located under some streets.


AND WHEREAS: The City Council must designate the period, which extends for 90 (ninety) days, that restricts the use of these roads and streets by heavy traffic.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IA:

Such embargo shall become effective on March 10, 1994, and continue until June 08, 1994. The embargo may be lifted earlier if street conditions improve.
