This Agreement is by and between the Bi-State Regional Commission, hereinafter called the "Commission", and the City of Buffalo, Iowa hereinafter called the "City".

A. SCOPE OF SERVICES

The Commission agrees to prepare an application to the Iowa Department of Economic Development for a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Public Facilities Grant.

Staff will work with the City and the engineering firm in completing the application. Staff will attend one public hearing.

B. CITY RESPONSIBILITY

The City shall advertise and conduct the two public hearing necessary for this application. The City will provide any necessary information to the Commission in completing the application. The City will liaison with the engineering firm in proving the Commission with the necessary cost estimates and components needed for completing the application.

The City shall provide documents in an accessible format, as required by the Americans with Disabilities Act, when requested by the public.

C. SCHEDULE

The Commission shall begin work on October 3, 1994 and complete the work on this project by December 31, 1994.

D. PROJECT RESULT

The Commission will forward the appropriate number of applications to the Iowa Department of Economic Development by December 15, 1994.

E. TERMINATION, OR AMENDMENT

This Agreement may be terminated or amended by mutual written consent of the Commission and the City. The City shall be liable for actual costs incurred by the Commission up to the date of termination or additional costs incurred by the Commission because of amendment(s).

F. HOLD HARMLESS

The City and its agents shall indemnify, save, and hold harmless the Commission and all its agents and employees of and from all losses, claims, demands, suits, actions, payments, or causes of action of whatever nature or character arising out of or by reason of personal property damage, bodily injury, or otherwise brought or recovered against the Commission, its agents or employees, including any and all expenses, legal or otherwise, incurred by the Commission, its agents and employees in the defense of any claim or suit as a result of this Agreement.

G. RIGHT TO REPRODUCE

The Commission retains the right to publish, at its cost, additional copies of any documents prepared under the Agreement without prior permission of the City.

H. COMPENSATION

The City agrees to pay the Commission the sum of one thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$1,250.00) upon completion of the application.


