RESOLUTION OF THE BUFFALO, IOWA CITY COUNCIL
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND HOUSING NEEDS ASSESSMENT

WHEREAS; the Buffalo City Council is committed to addressing the needs of its citizens;
and

WHEREAS; the City of Buffalo has provided the opportunity for its citizens to identify
community needs during a public hearing held on November 7, 1994.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Buffalo City Council, Buffalo, Iowa, as follows:

1. Community development and housing needs of low and moderate income persons -
 - A. Senior Housing;
 - B. Five year curb/gutter upgrading plan for residents in the west end of the City;
and
 - C. Water improvements to the entire community.
2. Other community development and housing needs -
 - A. Installation of street lights throughout various intersections in the City;
 - B. Five year Fire Department upgrade plan, including new fire station.
3. Planned or potential activities to address housing and community needs -
 - A. Purchase of land for additional 13 unit residential area;
 - B. Develop rental property inspection/code to help protect renters and landlords;
 - C. Purchase of new fire truck; and
 - D. Extend storm sewers to river.
