RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF
QUAD CITIES, IOWA/ILLINOIS
MISSISSIPPI RIVER CORRIDOR DESIGN PRINCIPLES

WHEREAS, the Quad City Waterfront Master Plan was adopted in May, 1994 by the major communities/counties of the Quad City Metropolitan Area to outline future public and private economic development, investment and preservation of the Quad City Riverfront; and

WHEREAS, the River Corridor Framework Plan subsequently outlined special attributes of the River Corridor from Buffalo to LeClaire, Iowa and Andalusia to Port Byron, Illinois including existing river features, planned improvements, and potential improvements; and


WHEREAS, a vision for our Mississippi River Corridor, the River and its Riverfront is set forth to be vital, distinctive and accessible, coordinated in its use, integrated through good design and cared for by us all; and

WHEREAS, a source book of principles for good design in the River Corridor has been created to offer guidance on river access, river setting and resource enhancement drawing from this vision and on the Waterfront Master Plan and Framework Plan as its foundation;
