

RESOLUTION # 27-96

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IOWA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO CLOSE THE CITY OF BUFFALO FEMA 404 HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT AGREEMENT (NO. 996-0031) WITH THE IOWA EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DIVISION.

WHEREAS: The City of Buffalo has received Disaster Assistance from the Federal Emergency Management Agency to acquire one (1) substantially damaged house.

WHEREAS: All efforts have been exhausted to acquire this property resulting in the purchase of one (1) home at 104-106 Franklin Street and the voluntary withdrawal of the remaining two (2) properties.

Now therefore, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Buffalo, Iowa, as follows:

- 1. The City Council acknowledges the expenditure of \$38,342.00 to complete the buyouts and one (1) elevation.
- 2. Is in concurrence with the efforts by the Iowa Emergency Management Division to close the project on behalf of the City.
