

RESOLUTION # 15 - 2000

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A THREE (3) YEAR CONTRACT FOR GARBAGE AND RECYCLE PICKUP FROM WASTE MANAGEMENT:

WHEREAS: Waste Management has been the City's waste hauler for approximately the past 10 months.

AND WHEREAS: Waste Management has submitted a bid to the City of Buffalo and was the ~~city~~ <sup>accepted</sup> bidder.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BUFFALO, IA:

The City of Buffalo hereby approves a three (3) year contract with Waste Management for the fiscal years up to and including June 30, 2003. The quoted prices will remain as follows as per their bid.

- YEAR #1 Waste/garbage pickup, including weekly recycles, and 1 large item per month, at \$7.77 per residence per month, inclusive.
- YEAR #2 Waste/garbage pickup, including weekly recycles, and 1 large item per month, at \$8.15 per residence per month, inclusive.
- YEAR #3 Waste/garbage pickup, including weekly recycles, and 1 large item per month, at \$8.50 per residence per month, inclusive.


Waste Management will furnish appliance stickers to City Hall to sell at \$15.00 per sticker, and City Hall will notify Waste Management when an appliance needs to be picked up. This amount may change as the Scott Area Solid Waste Management Commission changes the fees charged to the haulers.


Waste Management will furnish stickers to City Hall to sell at \$1.00 each (the price may change as the Compost Center changes their prices) to be attached to the paper bags for disposal of yard waste.

Waste Management will not charge the City of Buffalo for any dumpsters that are used by the City of Buffalo at various locations or for the waste in them.
