A RESOLUTION TO HIRE A FULL TIME POLICE OFFICER:

WHEREAS: There exists a vacancy for a full time police officer in the Buffalo Police Department.

AND WHEREAS: Interviews were conducted by the City Council and Police Chief.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BUFFALO, IA:

The City Council hereby approves the appointment of VICTOR OBERTANCE pending satisfactory completion of all required tests and examinations, to be a member of the Buffalo Police Department. He will be paid \$ 11.75 per hour, have a probation period of 1 year, at which time his performance will be reviewed. He must sign the agreement as prepared by the City Attorney relating to training reimbursement as described in the agreement. After his one (1) year probation, he will have a performance review by Chief Adams, and upon approval of Chief Adams, he will receive a .50¢ per hour increase in pay. At the time of his graduation from the Iowa Law Enforcement Academy, he will again have a performance review by Chief Adams, and upon approval, he will receive a \$1.00 per hour additional increase in wages.
