RESOLUTION 01-2001

WHEREAS, Resolution 25-97, which was approved by the City of Buffalo, discussed wages for the full-time and part-time police officers, as well as which holidays are to be worked by full-time and part-time police officers; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Buffalo to more clearly define the policy regarding police officers and which officers are to work during holidays,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of Buffalo, Iowa that the following language contained in Resolution 25-97 be rescinded:

Full time officers shall not work at least the following holidays: Martin Luther King's Birthday, President's Day, Good Friday, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, Thanksgiving Day, Veteran's Day, day shift is omitted the day after Thanksgiving (Friday). Other holidays shall be worked according to the union contract. These may be subject to change in the future.

The holiday work schedule work procedure in Resolution 25-97 is replaced with the following language:

All holidays shall be worked by full-time and part-time police officers according to the union contract, although part-time police officers shall work holidays whenever possible. The holiday work schedule may be subject to change in the future.
