

**RESOLUTION NO. 08-2002**

**TO OBTAIN BIDS FOR THE BUFFALO CITY HALL  
ELECTRIC SUBSTATION**

WHEREAS, the City of Buffalo, Iowa needs to upgrade its electrical substation next to city hall.

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project exceeds \$25,000.00,

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the city council of the City of Buffalo, Iowa that the city proceed to obtain bids, plans, specifications, form of contract, and estimated cost for the upgrade of the city hall electric substation as soon as possible.


1. The city shall publish in the Quad City Times an invitation for bids. The invitation for bids shall contain information, terms and conditions required by law.

2. The city will receive the bids until \_\_\_\_\_ on the \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2002 at Buffalo City Hall. All bids will publicly opened and read aloud at that time. The construction and improvements must begin within \_\_\_ days after received by the contractor of a notice to proceed, and must be completed no later than \_\_\_\_\_, 2002.

3. Upon the receipt of the bids the city council will hold a public hearing to discuss the proposed bids, plans, specifications, form of contract, and estimated cost of the city hall electric substation upgrade, at 7:00 p.m. on \_\_\_\_\_, 2002 in the city council chambers of city hall, Buffalo, Iowa. Notice of the public hearing will be published once in the Quad City Times, a newspaper in general circulation in the city, not less than four (4) or more than twenty (20) days before the meeting of the city council at which the proposal is to be considered.
