

RESOLUTION 24-2004

WHEREAS, Section 3-2.0240 of the Buffalo Municipal Code states that the owners of animals which are boarded shall be subject to a fee; and

WHEREAS, the boarding fees for the animals are to be determined and approved by the City Council pursuant to a resolution; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the boarding fees for animals shall be as follows:


- A. For each dog, cat, ferret or similar animal, a daily fee for the animal's care, food, water and shelter shall be \$6.50 per day.
- B. For each domestic fowl, chicken, goose, duck or water fowl, a daily fee for the animal's care, food, water and shelter shall be \$10.00 per day.
- C. For each horse, mule, jack, cow, bull, steer, ox, swine, sheep, goat or similar animal, a daily fee for the animal's care, food, water and shelter shall be \$30.00 per day.
- D. For any animal not specified herein, a daily fee of \$25.00 plus actual expenses incurred for the animal's care, food, water and shelter.
