

RESOLUTION 29-2004

WHEREAS, Section 3-2.0102 of the Buffalo Municipal Code requires that every dog and cat within the City of Buffalo be licensed; and

WHEREAS, the license fees are to be determined and approved by the City Council pursuant to a resolution; and


WHEREAS, the City Council has determined the appropriated annual license fees for cats and dogs;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the annual license fees for dogs and cats are as follows:

- A. For a neutered or spayed dog or cat, the annual fee is \$5.00.
- B. For a dog or cat which has not been neutered or spayed, the annual fee is \$30.00.
- C. For a dog which has been declared dangerous, the annual license fee is \$150.00.
- D. The annual license fee for a dog that has been declared a vicious dog is \$350.00.
- E. Residents age 60 and older and residents who are recipients of social security insurance benefits may license their neutered or spayed dogs or cats for an annual fee of \$1.00.
