

REGARDING CEMETERY'S FEES AND REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, Section 3-5.06 of the Buffalo Municipal Code states that all fees and charges for the cemetery shall be set out in rules and regulations as adopted by the City Council; and,

WHEREAS, Section 3-5.11 of the Buffalo Municipal Code states that the City Council shall adopt rules and regulations regarding the hours of opening and closing, the use of roads within the cemetery, the hours for burials, as well as other services provided by the City; and,

WHEREAS, there is currently a need to increase the fees charged for the cemetery as well as to amend the rules and regulations of the cemetery;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, as follows:

1. Residents of the City of Buffalo, ^{and Buffalo Township} shall be charged \$350.00 for two graves and charged \$700.00 for four graves. Non-residents of the City of Buffalo, ^{and Buffalo Township} shall be charged \$1,800.00 for two graves and \$3,600.00 for four graves.

2. There shall be an opening and closing fee of \$425.00 per grave for residents of the City of Buffalo. Non-residents of the City of Buffalo, ^{and Buffalo Township} shall pay an opening and closing fee of \$745.00 per grave.

3. The fee for infants for residents of the City of Buffalo, ^{and Buffalo Township} shall be \$100.00 for a two-foot by two-foot burial in a family plot, or \$220.00 for a two-foot by two-foot plot to be purchased. Buffalo ^{TOWNSHIP} residents shall be charged \$100.00 for cremated remains in a family plot or \$220.00 for cremated remains in a two-foot by two-foot plot to be purchased. For non-residents the price will be the same as the non-resident pricing discussed in item #2.

4. There shall be no burials on Sundays or holidays. There shall also be no burials after 3:00 p.m. on weekdays. This includes the interment of cremated remains.
