A RESOLUTION REGARDING CITY HALL COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Buffalo City Council at its July 11, 2005 meeting voted to review the feasibility of moving City Hall from its current location to the Buffalo Activity Center; and

WHEREAS, the costs, ^{logistics} benefits and ~~disadvantages~~ of moving the City Hall from its present location to the Buffalo Activity Center requires further input and study;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that there is hereby established a City Hall Committee. The City Hall Committee shall consist of three citizens of the City of Buffalo, the Public Works Director, the City Clerk, and two City Council members, for a total of seven committee members. The committee shall review the current and future needs of the Buffalo City Hall, and shall gather cost estimates and study the cost savings, if any, if the City Hall is moved to the Buffalo Activity Center, ~~as well as determining if moving City Hall to the Buffalo Activity Center meets the City's current and future needs. The committee shall also review the other benefits and disadvantages of moving Buffalo City Hall from its current location to the Buffalo Activity Center.~~

The members of the committee may be nominated by the Mayor and shall be approved by the City Council members. If the Mayor is unable to fill the nominations for the committee within thirty days, then the City Council members may propose and approve the committee appointments. The task of the committee is recommended to be completed within six months of the date of passage. THE MEMBERS FOR APPOINTMENT ARE AS FOLLOWS:
