**Resolution #03-2006**

A Resolution For Street Embargo


**WHEREAS**, the City of Buffalo may require a temporary street embargo each spring to protect the roadways.


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Common Council of the City of Buffalo, that the Council hereby a Temporary Embargo on the weight of vehicles to be operated within the city limits as allowed in Municipal Code Section 2.1-2.0702 "Temporary Embargo". This embargo will become effective on March 14, 2006 and will be in force up to, but no longer than 90 days in the calendar year.

The proper signs and flags will be installed on streets in the City when the Embargo is in effect.
