A Resolution Supporting the Improvements to Highway 22 for the Construction of an Ethanol Plant in the City of Buffalo

WHEREAS, the City of Buffalo recognizes that Economic Development is in the best interests of it's residents and

WHEREAS, the construction of an Ethanol Plant in the City of Buffalo will require improvements to the entrance to the plant as well as to Iowa State Highway 22 and


WHEREAS, the City is negotiating with a specific developer for the construction of the Ethanol Plant which will create permanent jobs in the City of Buffalo and

WHEREAS, the City of Buffalo assures the State of Iowa of a minimum 20% match as financial participation in the Revitalize Iowa's Sound Economy (RISE) grant funding for the construction project.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Buffalo, Iowa endorses said construction project and agrees to apply for RISE funding for the improvements to Highway 22 required by the construction of an Ethanol Plant, and further agrees that the City of Buffalo will contribute funding to the extent necessary to supplement RISE funding to complete the proposed highway improvements.
