A Resolution adopting the National Incident Management System concept of Emergency Planning

WHEREAS, the City of Buffalo recognizes that Emergency Response to critical incidents, whether natural or man-made, requires integrated management, and


WHEREAS, the Unified Command of such incidents is recognized as the management model to maximize the public safety response, and

WHEREAS, the National Incident Management System herein referred to as NIMS, has been identified by the Federal Government as being the requisite emergency management system for all political subdivisions.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Buffalo, Iowa adopts the NIMS concept of emergency planning and unified command for use in the city of Buffalo as its system of preparing for and responding to emergencies, and direct that appropriate city officers and employees be trained in the use of NIMS.
