FULL-TIME POLICE OFFICER

The Buffalo Police Department is now accepting applications for one position of FULL-TIME POLICE OFFICER. Applications can be picked up at Buffalo City Hall, 329 Dodge Street Buffalo, IA between the business hours of 8am-4pm Monday through Friday or you can print an application from our website, www.buffaloiowa.org.

Requirements:

- Must have obtained a minimum of a high school diploma or GED
- Must be 18 years of age or older
- Must possess a valid Iowa Driver's License
- Must pass a thorough background investigation
- No felony convictions
- Must pass drug screen and physical
- Must pass psychological evaluation
- Non-certified applicants will be required to perform and pass the written P.O.S.T. test and physical agility standards test as required by the Iowa Law Enforcement Academy
- Current certified officers will be required to pass the physical agility standards if they have had a 180 day or more of separation in law enforcement employment

Iowa Law Enforcement Certification is preferred, but not required.

All completed applications and resume must be dropped off or mailed to Buffalo City Hall. Applications will be accepted through **Tuesday, October 17th, 2017** at 4pm. If you are mailing an application, address as follows:
