

Maximum Property Tax Levy Public Hearing

March 23, 2026

The Special Meeting of the Buffalo City Council was called to order at 6:02 p.m. by Mayor Rodriguez. Council Members Rachel Teel-Vanderpool, Jesse Leonard, Sean Roman, Trent Adams, and Mary Moore were present. Also attending were Public Works Director Josh Ferkel, Police Chief T.J. Behning, Fire Chief Doug Anderson, and City Clerk Tanna Leonard. Motion by Roman, seconded by Teel-Vanderpool to open the Max Levy Hearing. Motion carried unanimously.


Two members of the public provided comments:

- One resident expressed concern about the proposed increase in the levy, stating that Buffalo already has high taxes and too much equipment, and questioned the need for additional spending.
