RESOLUTION NO. 2026-09

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUPPORT FOR THE ANNUAL COMMUNITY EASTER EGG HUNT AND DETERMINING PUBLIC PURPOSE

WHEREAS, the City of Buffalo values community events that promote family recreation, civic engagement, and positive use of public spaces; and

WHEREAS, the annual Community Easter Egg Hunt held in Buffalo City Park is a free event open to all residents and visitors, consistently drawing a large turnout and providing a safe, inclusive activity that enhances quality of life; and

WHEREAS, the volunteer organizers prepare the park before the event and clean the park afterward, reducing the burden on city staff and supporting the maintenance of public property; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that supporting this event serves a clear public purpose under Iowa law by promoting community welfare, encouraging park use, and fostering positive community engagement; and

WHEREAS, City funds will be used solely for the purchase of event supplies and prizes, with receipts submitted to the City for review and documentation, and no funds will be used for personal compensation or private benefit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Buffalo, Iowa, that:

1. The City hereby authorizes financial support for the Annual Community Easter Hunt in an amount not to exceed \$1,000.
2. All expenditures shall be documented with receipts and reviewed by the City Clerk for compliance with municipal purchasing and public-purpose requirements.
3. Funds shall be used exclusively for supplies, prizes, and materials necessary for the public event.
4. No advance payment shall be made to private individuals; reimbursement will occur only upon submission of receipts.
