

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-24

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PUBLIC TOWN HALL MEETING REGARDING THE MUNICIPAL WATER AND SEWER UTILITIES AND SETTING THE DATE, TIME, AND LOCATION

WHEREAS, the City of Buffalo, Iowa, owns and operates municipal water and sewer utilities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is evaluating whether the sale of the municipal water and sewer utilities is in the best interest of the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to provide residents with an opportunity to receive information, ask questions, and offer feedback in a public town hall setting; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it appropriate and beneficial to hold a town hall meeting for the purpose of public engagement and transparency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Buffalo, Iowa, as follows:

1. Town Hall Meeting Authorized. The City Council hereby authorizes a public town hall meeting to discuss the municipal water and sewer utilities and related matters.
2. Date, Time, and Location. The town hall meeting shall be held on August 31, 2026, from 5:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m., at the Buffalo Community Center, 426 Clark Street, Buffalo, Iowa.
3. Purpose. The purpose of the town hall meeting is to provide information to residents, answer questions, and receive public input regarding the municipal water and sewer utilities and potential future actions, including consideration of a possible sale.
4. Notice and Communication. The City Clerk is directed to prepare and distribute public notices, website postings, and other communications necessary to inform residents of the town hall meeting.
5. Further Action. City staff are authorized to take all steps necessary to facilitate the town hall meeting, including preparation of materials, coordination of presenters, and arrangement of the meeting space.
