

The City of Buffalo has been working with the Bi-State Regional Commission to get funding for the development of the Mississippi River Trail (MRT) and American Discovery Trail (ADT), two national trails, through the City of Buffalo and into Muscatine County. The City is proud to be awarded a grant from Iowa's State Recreational Trails Program for \$108,500. The grant funds will work in conjunction with \$450,000 in federal funds identified from SAFETEA –LU to further the development of the MRT and ADT in Muscatine and Scott Counties. The funds will be used for the final alignment study and engineering of the trail connecting it with Davenport via the Credit Island Trail Bridge that is to be constructed in 2012 as well as the recently completed trail in Muscatine and Wild Cat Den State Park.
